This vibrantly tropical Sauvignon Blanc is fresh and lively, a great aperitif and an ideal partner for smoked salmon, grilled fish, shellfish dishes and summer salads

Gamay is the grape used to make Fleurie and all Beaujolais. These grapes come from vineyards surrounding Lyon—wine is unoaked and very juicy and almost sweet.

Vibrant cherry red, with a nose dominated by raspberry and strawberry fruit and elegant, lifted vanilla notes. The palate is supple and soft, with moderate tannins.

Very expressive and seductive nose of fresh cut fruit, candied wild strawberry. Subtle, easy tannins with slight black pepper notes on the finish.

Gentle tannins, concentrated blackberry flavours, and a lingering finish. Intense berry and spice aromas.
